


Description of the Rallye

- A Gimmick Rallye is one in which the Rallymasters present route instructions and questions that the alert Rallyists must follow and answer along the route.
- Answers to questions may be found on either side of the road, however it will be noted if an answer is on the left side of the road. (SOL)
- There will be an entrants meeting at the start to go over General rules for this particular Rallye
- Other examples of Gimmick Rallies would be Scrambled word Rallye, Photo Rallye, and Landmark Rallye.
- An entrant MUST be able to start and finish the Rallye by only using the instructions given them at the start and Generals.
- It is advisable to bring a clipboard and pens or pencils to answer questions.
- Participants should not have to exit the car in order to answer any questions. A CHECKPOINT is usually included at midpoint for restrooms etc
- Time and mileage will be a factor in most Rallies
- We want to make this 1st annual Rallye a rather simple one so that everyone has a FUN time.
- The endpoint will give everyone a chance to order food, and discuss what a great time they had!
- The entry fee will be \$5.00 only per car so that trophies can be given to winners for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.

In what was one of the shortest model years, a total of 9,686 Corvettes were produced. Production started June 5, 2017 and ends January 28, 2018. The plant was down for three months, making the 2018 model year approximately 5 months.

- Here's how the options panned out:
- •39.3% Stingrays; 31.8% Grand Sport; 28.9% Z06
- •17.5% of Corvettes built were convertibles
- •Automatic transmissions outsold manuals once again at 78%.

•The 1LT package was most popular for Stingray Coupes, while the 2LT was the top pick for Stingray Convertibles and Grand Sports. The 3LZ was again the most popular for Z06 models.

- Almost 30% of Z06s opted for the Z07 performance package.
- Arctic White once again topped the list as most popular color, and for the first time in several years – when you add the two 'reds' together, they don't beat out white (just barely though)!

Restored 1962 Corvette to be Revealed on 4th Anniversary of Sinkhole

Nearly four years ago many Corvette enthusiasts across the globe woke up to some startling news. A massive sinkhole had opened inside the National Corvette Museum in Bowling Green, Kentucky - taking eight Corvettes into its depths. Over the past year, work has been performed on the Museum-owned 1962 "sinkhole" Corvette inhouse at the AutoZone Maintenance and Preservation Area by Vehicle Maintenance and Preservation Coordinator Daniel Decker, with the help of Curator Derek Moore and other members of the NCM team.

On Monday, February 12, 2018 the restored 1962 will be placed back in its original pre-sinkhole display space in the Skydome and revealed to the public. A ceremony will be held in the Skydome at 9:00am CT, and broadcast live on the Museum's Facebook page.





- 1. Abbreviations used in Rallye for directions:
 - **R** Right
 - L Left
 - S Straight
 - SS Stop sign
 - TL Traffic Light
 - **RR** Railroad crossing
 - FAL First available Left
 - SOL Sign on Left
 - HTS Hard to See
 - CHECKPOINT
- 2. Since we expect many ties, there will be tie breakers
- 3. Rallye questions will consist of <u>Fill in the blank</u> and <u>Unscrambling words</u> pertaining to signage along the route. You will also have to locate items in attached pictures and fill in blanks associated with the pictures.
- The time allotted to complete the Rallye will be 2 1/4 hours.
 Failure to complete Rallye in allotted time will result in DNF. (Did Not Finish)
- A panic envelope will be given to each car that reveals the end point.
 If you turn in envelope opened, it will also be a DNF
- There will be a "CHECKPOINT" along the route which is mandatory for each car to stop. There will be restrooms if needed and each car will then also draw another POKER card

We begin the festivities with our Friday night "**Pre-Car Show Party**" at **Landmark Resort** overlooking the beautiful Atlantic Ocean. The maximum seating capacity for the pre-show party is 250. We have **protected parking** to walk around and view our cars, beautiful ambiance in the Banquet Room, delicious dinner, a DJ and dance floor, an easy-to-find location, enough space for a great time and fun for everyone.

The official host hotel of this year's car show is Landmark Resort, 1501 South Ocean Blvd, Myrtle Beach, SC 29577. The Myrtle Beach Corvette Club is a group of Corvette owners and enthusiasts who live and work along the Grand Strand. We meet monthly and support various charity events in Horry County, Georgetown County in South Carolina, and Brunswick County in North Carolina throughout the year.

"Corvettes at Myrtle Beach" is the official name of our annual Car Show fund raiser. This year it will be held on Saturday, June 2, 2018 at Broadway at The Beach. Show participants come from all along the East Coast (Florida to Maine), Ohio, Kentucky, Indiana, Missouri, Tennessee, Kansas, Texas, and as far north as Canada. The show is open to the public with no admission fee. Our club is a social club and our primary purpose is to raise contributions to support charities located in Horry County and Georgetown County in South Carolina, and Brunswick County in North Carolina.

Our 2018 Car Show charities are: All4Paws (Tax# 45-3676896). All4Paws is run entirely on donations, grants and fundraisers along with a board to help guide business decisions. Veterans Welcome Home and Resource Center (Tax # 38-3801214). The center was founded by Veterans and others who support Veterans and their rights. Currently the center is staffed by all volunteers with a Board of Directors to oversee the operations of the center and the services that are provided.

We have three types of sponsorships available:

CAR SHOW SPONSOR: \$100 - We will provide to all car show participants any flyers, coupons or informational material you provide on your products or service. You or your company will be acknowledged as a sponsor on our Car Show T-Shirt.
