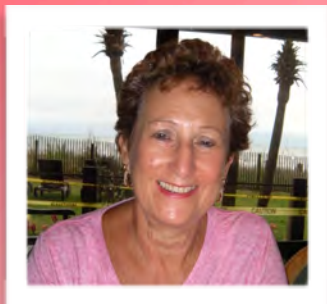

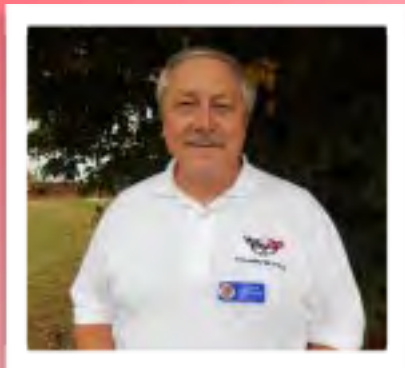
We will have one food vendor, an ice cream vendor, and a pretzel vendor. So, we are set for the food.

In January we announced professional road racer and Corvette Hall of Fame inductee Andy Pilgrim would be joining the team at the NCM Motorsports Park. We can announce today that Andy will also be moving his Traffic Safety Education Foundation, to Bowling Green, Kentucky.

Andy first became interested in road safety in the mid-90's as a give back project, initially speaking to high school students in FL. Wanting to take things further, he launched The Traffic Safety Education Foundation as an official 501(c)(3) organization in 2008.

Distracted driving is a growing epidemic in the US and the main cause for the massive increase in traffic deaths and injuries over the last 3 years. Andy has produced several educational videos to help improve things. They are aimed at new drivers, parents with children of all ages and driver education teachers.

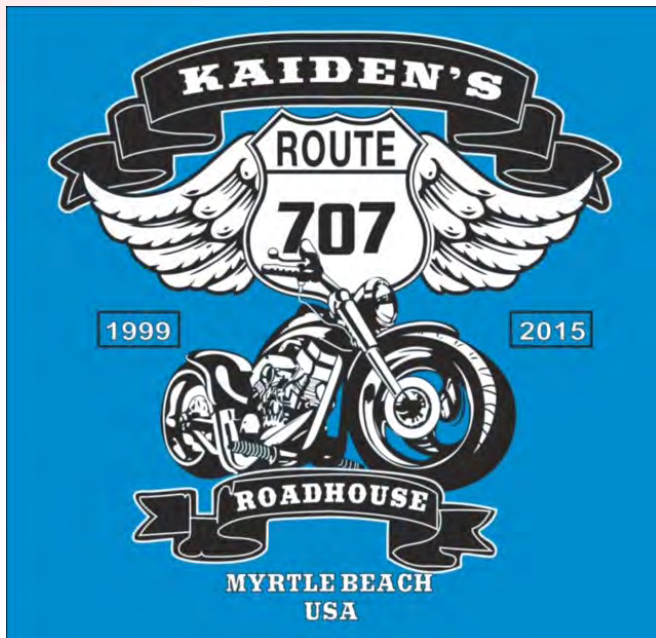

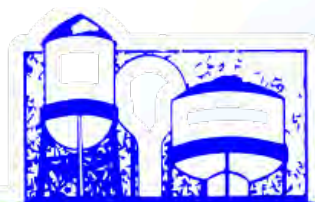
