

We Might Not See It Until Summer 2019


Originally, we'd heard that the mid-engine Corvette would debut at the 2019 Detroit Auto Show. Don Sherman, an automotive journalist who's been on the mid-engine 'Vette beat longer than anyone, reported in *Hagerty* that's when the C8 would debut. That doesn't seem to be the case anymore. For one reason or another—possibly because the Detroit Auto Show is drawing less interest than before ahead of a move to June in 2020—Chevrolet is not expected to debut the car until the summer. There's a rumor that the car's electrical systems needed reengineering, delaying the reveal by a few months.

GM Authority reports that the C8 will be revealed at a standalone event, possibly in May, though we'll keep our eyes peeled at the New York Auto Show in April. And if you're in Michigan, you might see a prototype or two on the street:

During winter cold weather they open for lunch serving soup, bread, dessert and sweet tea. There is no charge to those guests. They are currently serving dinner to approximately 75 to 80 people per night.
