What is Torque Converter Shudder?

Driving between 25 and 80 MPH, there is a sudden shudder in the vehicle. It almost feels like running over a rough spot in the road or a cattle guard. As quick as it appeared, it is gone, until the next time it occurs. The TCC shudder condition is related to moisture content in the transmission fluid. The current fluid tends to be hygroscopic, or absorbs moisture, which increases the chance of TCC shudder.

Susan and I had this experience shortly after we purchased our C7 coupe and traveled to Savannah with the club. At first I wondered if the roads could be causing the problem as we had not traveled on 17 that far south. On the return trip I spent time changing driving conditions to diagnose the cause of this phenomenon.

Using my go-to resources for problem solving (Google or YouTube), It became obvious I was not alone. Then I contacted my dealer and made an appointment to verify the problem and have it fixed. Since then I have followed this issue and found it occurs with cars and trucks and has been reported with other manufacturers as well. My latest info regarding GM, is the fluid used appears to be the root cause. A new formulation was introduced in the 2017 model year and a new procedure for changing (flushing) the system as recent as 2019. At this time our issues appear to have been resolved.

A new transmission fluid exchange procedure and a new formula of Mobil 1 Synthetic LV ATF HP transmission fluid have been released to address torque converter clutch (TCC) shudder conditions on 8L45 and 8L90 8-speed automatic transmissions (RPOs M5N, M5T, M5U, M5X) in some 2015-2017 Escalade, Yukon; 2015-2018 Silverado, Sierra; 2015-2019 Corvette; 2016-2018 CT6; 2016-2019 ATS, CTS, Camaro; and 2017-2019 Colorado and Canyon models. John Grover - Historian

In 1953. General Motors and Chevrolet introduced the Corvette. 300 were made, and this is the story of #211, built on November 12, 1953 in Flint, Michigan. In 1955, Chevrolet had only manufactured 500 Corvettes, so consideration was given to discontinuing the Corvette for 1956. To help save the Corvette, The Daytona Beach NASCAR Unit was created by Chevrolet, and it's widely believed this was a "probable effort" by GM and NASCAR's Bill France to save the Corvette from extinction. #211 was chosen to be the first NASCAR Corvette. A second Corvette, a 1955, #399, was added and both were redesigned to very specific specifications by The Chevrolet Experimental Shop and Garage.

I mention this because in November of 1958, Gray Tuttle and his wife Judy, who were to become my next-door neighbors in Surfside Beach, purchased the remains of #211 Corvette from NASCAR and Gray became the first titled owner. He told me what he paid for it and I can't remember the exact amount, although I believe it was in \$2000 range. The



book says Gray "rescued #211 from the perils of being an old beat up NASCAR racer". He rebuilt it and in 1968 sold it, if I remember him correctly, for not much more than he paid for it to a gentleman from Canada. Fifty year after he sold it, he was asked and was able to "provide conclusive evidence that helped identify #211 as the original NASCAR Daytona Beach and Carolina Racer."

Oldest Corvette Racer



Gray, Judy and I became friends because of our mutual love of Corvettes. He started bringing me news articles, photos and, eventually, this magazine (see photo). His/their photos are interspersed throughout this book beginning in 1960 to 2014. The last information I have shows the car at ProTeam Sports Sales in Napoleon, Ohio.

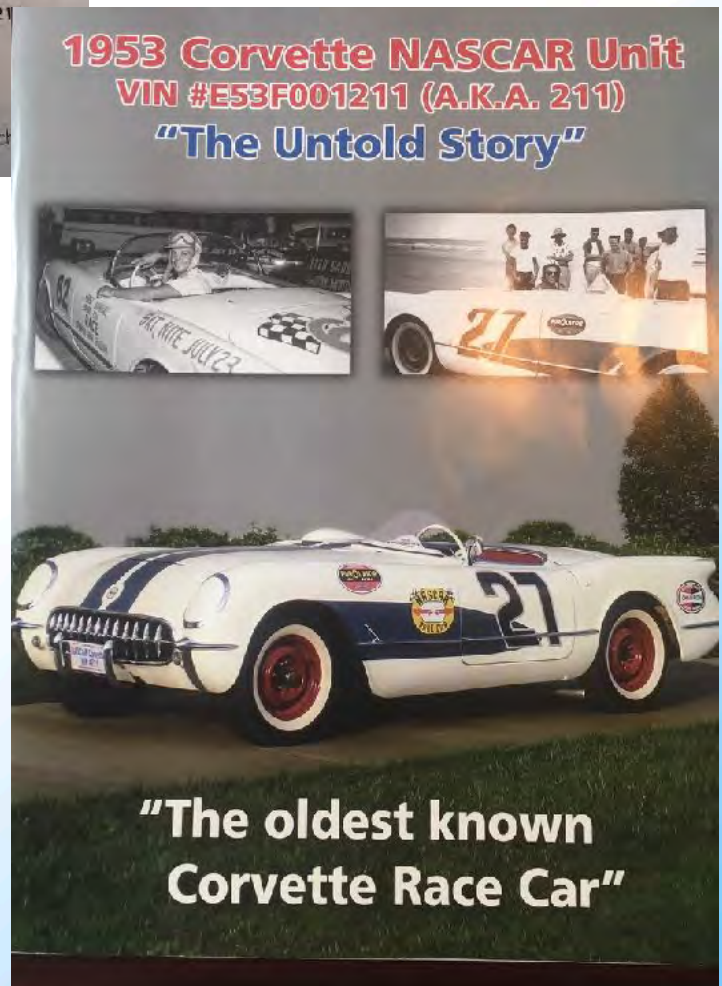

They were also bringing in a tent to help get through the event.

Club member arrived and with a positive attitude and hard work, the show was open at 8am!!
