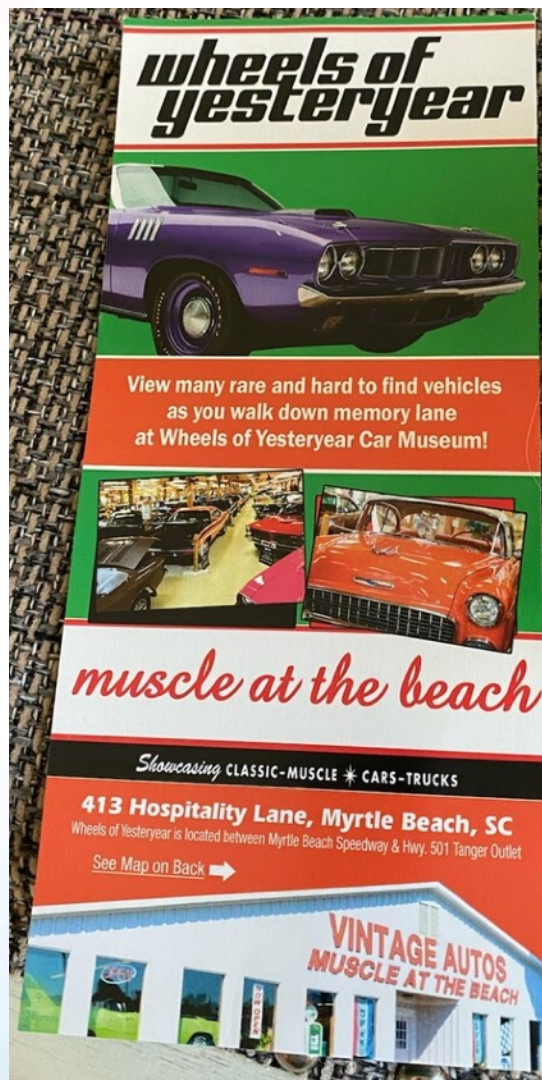

Barbara Grenfell will have the ladies use her bathroom and the men will use the restroom in the "hangar".


