The National Corvette Museum is licensed by the Kentucky Department of Charitable Gaming under license number ORG0000854.

At this time, we offer purchasers located in Kentucky the ability to purchase raffle tickets on their personal computers, mobile devices and on-site at the National Corvette Museum and NCM Motorsports Park.

To purchase a raffle ticket online, you must be at least 18 years of age

and be physically located in Kentucky at the time of purchase. You do not have to be a resident of Kentucky to participate.

If you are not located in Kentucky and will be using a credit card as your form of payment, you can use the site to interactively create an order form. The payment information will be encrypted for your protection and broken into two parts, some of which will only be on the printed form.

YOU MUST HAVE ACCESS TO A PRINTER AT THE TIME THAT YOU CREATE THE ORDER.

Alternatively, you may download an Order Form from this site and type in your information before sending to the NCM for processing.





At our June meeting last week, I announced I was planning a trip to Hilton Head for the Concourse de Elegance car show on Saturday November 6th and Sunday the 7th. There will be a different group of cars each day as well as an exhibit of antique airplanes. The Concourse shows are different from your average show in that exhibitors need to apply and be accepted to show their vehicles. The Concourse shows also differ from the average car show in that many of the cars are extremely rare classics and often one-of-a-kind vehicles that could be in the 6 maybe even the 7-dollar figures. You will also see some high end manufactures like Porsche, Lamborghini, Maserati and others displaying their latest models.

The show is November 6th and 7th but we will leave on Friday the 5th and come home either Sunday the 7th or Monday morning the 8th. Staying Sunday night is optional. I have reserved a block of rooms at the Holiday Inn Express where we have stayed twice before. The nightly rate total is \$143.19 which is all inclusive. There is a complimentary breakfast, a gym, and an outdoor pool where we have been known to have a Happy Hour before dinner every night. And yes, I will make arrangements for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday dinners for everyone that does not go home after the show Sunday. You will be responsible for calling the hotel to make your reservation. Their phone number is 843-842-6662. Make sure you tell them you are with the MBCC and how many nights you will be staying. Cut off for making reservations is October 6th.

Tickets for the two-day show will be \$90 per person. That's \$45 per day. I will order them the first week in October and hand them out to everyone in Hilton Head.
