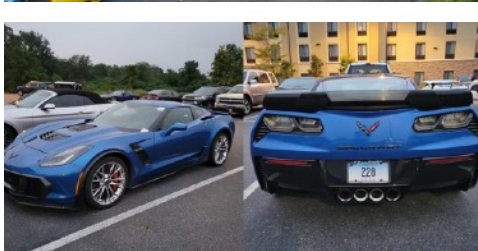
There were over 5,000 Corvettes present at the event this weekend.

Ron Fellow's Driving Experience

After the purchase of a new mid-engine corvette, owners have a bonus to attend Ron Fellow's Corvette Driving School within the first year of ownership.

GM underwrites the majority of the cost. We did the summer special for \$800.00 out of pocket and other times of the year is \$1,000. The special included 2 nights of accommodations in a spacious room with a kitchen, buffet breakfast and lunch served both days. The resort offers many amenities.

Personally, I had a wonderful experience driving a new mid-engine Z-51 corvette. All the corvettes (approx. 175) are exactly the same as off the show room floor without modifications.

Lap speeds can reach 100 (+/-) mph on the straight. The track is not designed for excessive speeds as to learning how to handle corvettes.

As a side note, Gloria and several other spouses were given the opportunity to have a drive along ride with one of the instructors. Those speeds reached 111 mph. Gloria was the only spouse to ride both days.

The course was beneficial to my understanding the capabilities of the new corvette. I highly recommend the course.

At our June meeting last week, I announced I was planning a trip to Hilton Head for the Concourse de Elegance car show on Saturday November 6th and Sunday the 7th. There will be a different group of cars each day as well as an exhibit of antique airplanes. The Concourse shows are different from your average show in that exhibitors need to apply and be accepted to show their vehicles. The Concourse shows also differ from the average car show in that many of the cars are extremely rare classics and often one-of-a-kind vehicles that could be in the 6 maybe even the 7-dollar figures. You will also see some high end manufactures like Porsche, Lamborghini, Maserati and others displaying their latest models.

The show is November 6th and 7th but we will leave on Friday the 5th and come home either Sunday the 7th or Monday morning the 8th. Staying Sunday night is optional. I have reserved a block of rooms at the Holiday Inn Express where we have stayed twice before. The nightly rate total is \$143.19 which is all inclusive. There is a complimentary breakfast, a gym, and an outdoor pool where we have been known to have a Happy Hour before dinner every night. And yes, I will make arrangements for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday dinners for everyone that does not go home after the show Sunday. You will be responsible for calling the hotel to make your reservation. Their phone number is 843-842-6662. Make sure you tell them you are with the MBCC and how many nights you will be staying. Cut off for making reservations is October 6th.

Tickets for the two-day show will be \$90 per person. That's \$45 per day. I will order them the first week in October and hand them out to everyone in Hilton Head.
