The Myrtle Beach Corvette Club (MBCC) is a group of Corvette owners and enthusiasts who live and work along the Grand Strand. We meet monthly and support various charity events in Horry County and Georgetown County in South Carolina, and Brunswick County in North Carolina throughout the year.

"Corvettes at Myrtle Beach" is the official name of our annual Car Show fund raiser. This is the 25th Annual event being held on Saturday, June 4, 2022 at Broadway at the Beach. Show participants come from all along the East Coast (Florida to Maine), Ohio, Kentucky, Indiana, Missouri, Tennessee, Kansas, Texas and as far north as Canada. The show is open to the public with no admission fee. **MBCC is a 501-c-3 charity** (tax ID# 80-0902100) and our primary purpose is to raise contributions to support charities located in the counties mentioned above.

Our 2022 Car Show charities are:

CANINE ANGELS a 501-c-3 non-profit organization that rescues dogs from shelters and rehabilitates them. They train service dogs for disabled veterans and certify handler/dog teams. They also train dogs for children with autism and down syndrome, and firefighters and first responders with PTSD.

CONWAY QUILT GUILD a 501-c-3 non-profit organization whose mission is to promote fellowship, inspiration and the perpetuation of all quilting techniques, to sponsor and support quilting activities that are of service to our community. They donate quiltlets for newborns, comfort quilts and pillow cases for oncology patients, animal beds for Horry County Animal Shelter, breast cancer pillows, walker bags, adult bibs, Covid masks, and honor Veterans with Quilts of Valor.

We have three types of sponsorships available plus additional ways to support the event:

CAR SHOW SPONSOR: \$100 - We will provide to all car show participants any flyer, coupons or informational material you provide on your products or service.

How It All Starts: NCM Delivery is referred to as OPTION "R8C" and is available through any Chevrolet Dealer at a cost of \$995.00. It must be specified at the time the order is finalized and a special Ship Code of "184590" must also be used to identify your Corvette for Museum Delivery.

Now Offering Ground Effects and Rocker Panel Extension Installs!

The Communications: The National Corvette Museum will contact the customer and offer a reasonable time frame in which the customer can choose a date for delivery. The first available date for delivery is approximately two (2) weeks from the offline date of the car. Once the car is built and its release from GM is confirmed a representative from the NCM Delivery Department will contact the customer to schedule their delivery date. The Museum will confirm the date, agreed upon by the customer, through email and will handle all further communications. If at any time the selling dealer and/or customer should have any questions regarding the delivery, they may contact the Museum at 1-800-205-4248.

The Paperwork: Customers must arrive at the NCM with the following items before a delivery can take place:

- A License Plate or Temporary Tag
- Proof of Ownership (Bill of sale, etc.)
- Proof of Insurance
- Valid Operator's License
- **Dealer Acknowledgement Form** (download, print, fill out and return to the Museum via fax, email or mail)

The Delivery: The customer arrives at the NCM with up to three additional guests of age 10 and up, total (4) and is welcomed with signs commemorating the event. A personal, special VIP guided tour of the NCM is conducted where they will see their Corvette on display. Next, a member of the NCM Delivery Team provides a quality orientation followed by a thorough delivery presentation of their new vehicle. A unique gold decal is placed on the inside of the drivers' door jamb to signify the importance of this memorable occasion. Customers also receive a personalized interior dash plaque, personalized wall plaque and an individual photograph in front of the Museum – weather permitting. Additionally, customers have the opportunity to purchase exclusive **merchandise** showcasing the "R8C Museum Delivery" logo, **bricks** in a special commemorative section, and build sheets/window stickers if available, during the program presentation. Deliveries can also be viewed world-wide via our live **webcams**.

The full line of Adam's Polishes products is available for purchase from the Corvette Store in-person or **online**.

The customer is presented with an individual one year NCM membership. Memberships which come with our R8C Museum Delivery program are upgradeable.

R8C customers have the opportunity to get on track in OUR Corvettes at the **NCM Motorsports Park** by purchasing touring laps at a discounted rate. Laps are not available during private events, or while the track is in use by an event. Track availability is also dependent on weather. 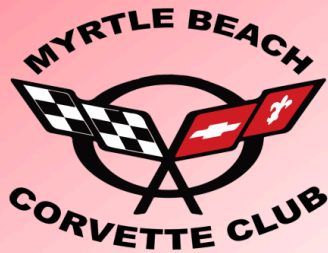

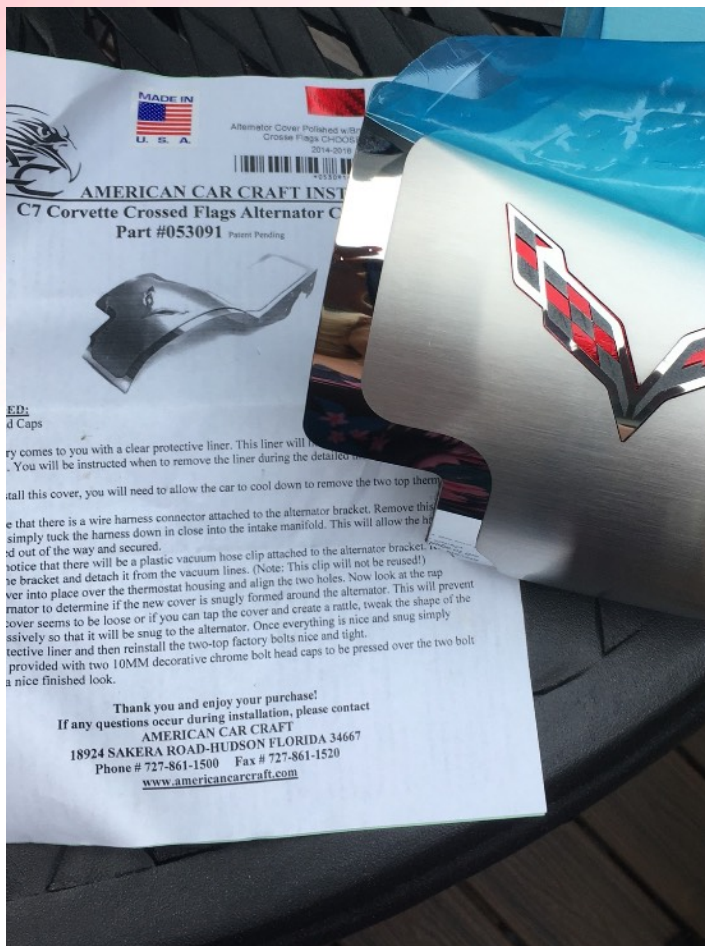
