Well, our 25th Anniversary Corvettes at the Beach car show is moving along very well. At this time we have 96 registered outside participants and 41 MBCC registered. That's awesome! We are way ahead of where we have been in past years.

We are working on getting our vendors together. Unfortunately, BATB has put a bit of a crimp in our style and any vendors that conflict with a store at BATB cannot be represented at our show. The same goes for food vendors. But, we'll do fine. We presently have: Advanced Auto, State Farm, Coastal Coating, Leaffilter, All Hands Auto Detailing, Keen Parts, the NCM and Edward Jones. Also, MB Chevrolet will be bringing up to 3 vehicles, as well as Auto World of Conway, another big sponsor we've had for several years.

I want to thank all of you that have stepped up to volunteer for parking, judging, 50/50, registration, tricky tray baskets, hospitality bags, front gate, and water and ice detail. I think that parking this year will be a bit easier for our volunteers since clubs will be parking together, and most are familiar with the way their cars park.

I have spoken with a restaurant at BATB and they will be setting up a food tent on the premises near our vendors and DJ. They will be offering a couple of choices of breakfast sandwiches and lunch choices as well.

I will be bringing the EVENT STAFF shirts to the April meeting and handing them out to those that are volunteering for the show. These shirts are cooler and lighter than the blue cotton ones we have had in the past. We ask that after the show, you launder the shirt and put it in a Ziploc bag with your name on it. We will collect them probably at the July meeting and store them in dry bins. I will be bringing Medium, Large and XL shirts and you will be checked off the list when you are given your shirt so we can keep track of them.

Again, I am requesting that all volunteers arrive at the car show no later than 7:30am, preferably earlier. In addition, please bring a case of water with you. We will have tables and chairs to set up as well as electrical to run. If there is anyone that has a background in electrical that has volunteered, we could use your help in the morning setting up wiring for the laptop at registration. We will have a 30x60 tent set up on lot 3 on Friday morning.

"Corvettes at Myrtle Beach" is the official name of our annual Car Show fund raiser. This is the 25th Annual event being held on Saturday, June 4, 2022 at Broadway at the Beach. Show participants come from all along the East Coast (Florida to Maine), Ohio, Kentucky, Indiana, Missouri, Tennessee, Kansas, Texas and as far north as Canada. The show is open to the public with no admission fee. MBCC is a 501-c-3 charity (tax ID# 80-0902100) and our primary purpose is to raise contributions to support charities located in the counties mentioned above.

Our 2022 Car Show charities are:

CANINE ANGELS a 501-c-3 non-profit organization that rescues dogs from shelters and rehabilitates them. They train service dogs for disabled veterans and certify handler/dog teams. They also train dogs for children with autism and down syndrome, and firefighters and first responders with PTSD.

CONWAY QUILT GUILD a 501-c-3 non-profit organization whose mission is to promote fellowship, inspiration and the perpetuation of all quilting techniques, to sponsor and support quilting activities that are of service to our community. They donate quiltlets for newborns, comfort quilts and pillow cases for oncology patients, animal beds for Horry County Animal Shelter, breast cancer pillows, walker bags, adult bibs, Covid masks, and honor Veterans with Quilts of Valor.
