Charities - Maggie Hood

Charities Nominated for 2023



We have six Charities nominated by members for consideration next year.

Associated Charities

Associated Charities is a 70 year old volunteer-operated charity that assists the homeless and impoverished in the Myrtle Beach, SC community. The organization is run completely by dedicated volunteers who give their free time to help keep the programs going to meet the needs of our community. They have two days a week, that the homeless and those in need can come. One day they can fill a bag at no cost and the second day the can fill a bag at a very low cost. All donated items are given to those in need. The money we give will support special programs, such as bike locks, diaper bags, bags for vets and the homeless.

Bikini Beach Cat Rescue

All funds raised for Bikini Beach Cat Rescue goes towards low-cost spay/neuter clinics to help animal parents and caretakers of feral cat colonies in need of assistance. To date, they have done more than 9,000 reduced-cost spay and neuters of cats and kittens for the community. Free-roaming cats are a a huge problem everywhere; recent estimates for Horry county is about 140,000 free-roaming cats and about 47,000 for Georgetown county. The Humane Society estimates that a breeding pair of cats and their kittens can produce more than 400,000 cats and kittens over 7 years. The money we give them will go to the spay and neutering.

Canine Angels

Canine Angels is a Charity that Rescues dogs from shelters and rehabilitates them. They train service dogs for disabled veterans and certify handler/dog teams. Train Dogs for Children with Autism and Down Syndrome. Train dogs for Firefighters and First Responders with PTSD. Educates the public about rights granted to service dog teams under federal law: The Americans with Disabilities Act. They take dogs to senior living facilities, nursing homes, schools, hospice, libraries, and more. Visits from these special angels, both the dogs and their handlers, are a gift to our community. The money we give them will go to the training of the dogs.

Conway Quilt Guild

The Conway Quilt Guild members are volunteers that serve our community by making Quiltlets for newborns at Conway Medical Center, Comfort Quilts and Pillow Cases for Waccamaw Oncology patients (Tidelands Health) and local Oncology units, including the new unit at CMC. They also make Quilts of Valor for Veterans, Animal Beds for Horry County Animal Shelter, Breast Cancer Pillows, Walker Bags, Adult Bibs, Fidget Quilts for local Assisted Living Homes, Quilt Bags for children in distress and COVID masks for Cancer Centers, Hospitals, etc. **The money we give them will go to supplies**.

A Day of Hope

A Day of Hope provides local underprivileged and homeless students services and supplies needed to prepare for a successful school year. Most importantly, they share the Love of Jesus and a message of Hope for their lives. A Day of Hope has one day of the year, the first Saturday in August, where they gather to distribute backpacks, school supplies, etc.. to the children. They will also have other services there to help them such as, hairdressers, dental, vision, medical screenings, etc... **The money we give them will be used for what they give to the children**.

Project Lighthouse

Project Lighthouse @ Sea Haven is a resource linkage, case management, and skill building program. This program is designed to help transitioned youth 18-24 successfully navigate their transition to independence and stability. This program includes (1) Street Outreach services, (2) a newly renovated drop-in Resource Center, and (3) Intensive Case Management services for those with immediate and critical needs in at least one area of transition to adulthood. Project Lighthouse @ Sea Haven also provides hygiene products along with clothing, hot meals and resources in 5 domains, which are; Education, Employment, Housing, Community Life Skills, and Health & Safety. The money we give will be used just for Project Lighthouse.













