Tours will go on sale to the public on Tuesday, November 1, 2022. National Corvette Museum members qualify for early booking access, beginning on Tuesday, October 25, 2022. Tour scheduling will take place at the time of purchase. At this time, tours can only be booked through the end of January 2023. Members can schedule and purchase plant tours by logging into their [Member's Only Portal](#).

Current Blackout dates are 11/8 – 11/18, 11/24 – 11/25, 12/5 – 12/9, 12/26 – 1/2.

Individuals must be ages 13 and up to participate in a plant tour. No bags, cameras, or open-toe shoes are permitted inside the building. Occasionally, due to circumstances outside of the National Corvette Museum's control, the plant may not be in normal production during part (or all) of your visit. Your scheduled tour will continue with your guide, sharing the full assembly process. Refunds and discount do not apply.

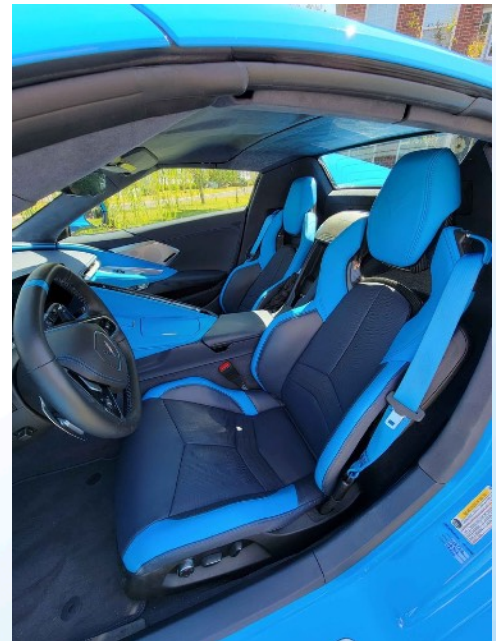
