N.C.M. Ambassador's Report By Dick Lawrence

We are less than 1 year away from the 30th anniversary caravan to the National Corvette Museum. Kim Shelton is our caravan coordinator. She anticipates sending hotel reservation information to both Sevierville, TN and to Bowling Green, KY by late Sept. to all who have sent in their registrations.

Our 4-state caravan will have a total of 170 rooms reserved in Bowling Green, KY, split between the Hampton Inn and the Embassy Suites which are both in close proximity to the museum. At this point, I was advised that our group does not have a problem with everyone staying in the same hotel. The sooner we get our reservations in the better. Kim wants to fill up the Hampton Inn first. We all need to make our own hotel reservations using the caravan information which will be advised. The hotels will check off from the master registration list.

The caravan departs Asheville, NC after lunch on Tuesday, Aug. 27, 2024, at the Deer Park Inn at the Biltmore. Tues., evening Aug. 27, we will spend the night in Sevierville. Wed., Aug. 28, the caravan arrives in Bowling Green thru Sun., Sept.1.

Cut off for the caravan is July 1, 2024, or when the total rooms are reserved. Currently many rooms are available.
