## Hello Members,

Well by the time you get this there will be less than 30 days until the car show on June 1 at Broadway at the Beach. Our dinner on Friday night, May 31, will be held at the Landmark Resort and that will begin at 5:30 pm. Online registration will be open until May 15, and there is still plenty of time to get your cars registered for the show and to sign up for the dinner on Friday night. As of today, we only have 58 cars from MBCC registered for the show, which is less than what we had last year. This is the biggest fundraiser for our charities so we need your support.

On Show Saturday we need all volunteers to arrive no later than 7:00 am. There will be a meeting for all parking and judging volunteers and we expect cars to start arriving by 7:30 am. The tent, port-a-potties and hand washing stations will be delivered and set up on Friday morning. Barricades will be set up on Thursday evening through the end of the show to keep shoppers and workers at Broadway at the Beach from parking in the lots. All that are coming to the car show are reminded to bring a case of water. It is not unusual to have 75-100 cases of water piled up under the tent. It will be June and it will be hot and EVERYONE, participants and volunteers included, will need to stay hydrated. The water is free to everyone and many times we get donations for the water. Our volunteers on golf carts will be passing out water and collecting for the 50/50 as well. Remember to bring hats, sunglasses and sun screen.

So now on to some good news. As of today, we have 214 cars registered for the show, 156 non-member cars and 58 MBCC cars. We still need more. We have 150 people signed up for the dinner on Friday night, 72 MBCC members and 78 non-members. The room will hold over 200 people so we still have room for a lot more. Doors open on Friday night at 5:30, with hors d'oeuvres, a cash bar and a buffet dinner. The band starts at 6:00 pm and will play until 10:00 pm. There's lots of fun checking out the baskets and taking a chance on them. The Friday night party is a great time and you will have a chance to meet some on the participants that will be at the show on Saturday.
