Chuck's career was cut short due to health issues. He impatiently waited for Barbara to get in her 25 years. One of the things that kept him busy while waiting, was purchasing a 2004 base model Vette. This vehicle (Betty) was his pride and joy and he pampered the car daily. He took a 14 day bucket list drive on all of Route 66 and returned home to NJ via Route 80. Barbara often referred to Betty as the "other woman".

In 2000, during the throes of COVID Barbara finally retired. They were headed to Florida to find a new home. The fates intervened and there was a huge storm headed to Florida. A friend had told them about Sunset Beach and that they owed it to themselves to check it out. They bought a pre-construction home in Ocean Isle Beach NC on day two of being in the area.

They loved getting acquainted with the area. Chuck would often take Betty for long car rides. It was his comfort, his solitude, his happy place until on April 14, 2023...

Chuck was in a horrible accident that totaled beloved Betty. He was in the hospital for weeks. The doctors were unsure if they could save his leg, and said in the best case scenario he would walk with an assistive device and have a severe limp. After many months of physical therapy, he made a full recovery, physically. Mentally, he missed his Vette, but was unsure if he would ever be able to overcome his fear of driving another one, or even have the courage to drive again.

Fast forward to 2024, Chuck found a beautiful 2004 Commemorative Edition blue convertible. He is so thankful to the previous owner in Surfside for selling him his beautiful, pristine car. Chuck can be found daily doting over his "Lady Blue". He now feels complete again.

As for Barbara, she is thrilled to see him whole again, and is happy to share him with "the other woman".
