August Ambassador's Report:

GM Races to complete 2025 Corvettes Production as 2026 Model Launches News
General Motors is racing to complete the 2025 Corvette production before the start
of the 2026 model lineup. The Bowling Green Assembly Plant in Kentucky is currently
producing the 2025 Corvette, with the final batch of orders to be fulfilled before the
2026 model begins production. The 2025 Corvette ZR1, known for its powerful
performance, is also facing supply-chain issues, with fewer than 70 units completed
by July 1, 2025. GM has informed dealers that they will be unable to fulfill all
remaining ZR1 orders for the 2025 model year, and buyers should expect price
increases for the 2026 models. The 2026 Corvette lineup will continue to offer a range
of performance levels, from the base Stingray to the track-focused ZR1 and rumored
ZR1X.


