Here is information on the nominated charities for 2026. Each member votes for 2 charities at the November meeting.

Army JROTC Booster Club at St. James High School, Murrells Inlet, SC

The St. James High School Army JROTC (The United States Army Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps) Booster Club is a 501(c)(3) charity that operates entirely through fundraising, as it receives no direct funding. While the JROTC program itself receives limited federal support for uniforms and some equipment, all extracurricular activities, competitions, and Cadet needs are sustained solely by the Booster Club. They provide financial support for students who cannot afford supplies, cover expenses for trips and competitions, and help organize events, concessions and fundraisers throughout the school year.

This JROTC program is one of the top in the nation and the only Honor Unit with Distinction in Horry County. We field several nationally competitive teams that are recognized as Varsity Sports by our school. Our Raider team consistently ranks among the best in the country, with national placements and state championships to their name. Our Leadership team has qualified for the JROTC Leadership and Academic National Championships six times (in Washington DC), while our Archery team regularly competes at the state and national levels. We also relaunched our Marksmanship team, quickly rising to become one of the top teams in the county.

Beyond competition, we actively serve our community by sponsoring one of the largest high school blood drives in South Carolina and hosting events like flag retirement ceremonies. With the support of the Booster Club—and potential partners like the Corvette Club—we can continue building on our success, supporting our Cadets, and representing our school and county at the highest levels.

Money raised will go towards supporting Cadets who cannot afford supplies, cover expenses for trips and competitions.

Christian Recovery Centers (Formerly Brunswick Christian Recovery Centers)

In 2010, Christian Recovery Centers (CRCI) opened at 1994 Ash Little River Rd NW in Ash, NC, originally serving 12 male residents. The center was donated by the North Carolina Wesleyan Church. Since then, through the expansion of its curriculum and services, the center has provided life-changing support for adult men and women struggling with addiction. CRCI focuses on individuals voluntarily seeking help for substance abuse, offering multiple recovery resources at no cost through a structured four-phase program.

This faith-based nonprofit provides free drug and alcohol treatment, recovery, and reentry services, helping residents build a foundation for long-term freedom and purpose.

Currently, 167 residents are served.

Funds raised will support a new building at Bryant's Orchard, a newly gifted property in Shallotte, NC, which will allow the center to serve 50 additional residents, bringing total capacity to 217 in Brunswick County. At certain dollar amounts, there is the opportunity to name parts of the building from various rooms to the lobby or courtyard. K12 Outfitters

Newly formed non-profit in 2024, K12 Outfitters is dedicated to providing homeless and underprivileged Horry County students with clothing they need to feel confident and comfortable to be ready to learn and succeed. In 2024 they provided 263 mini-wardrobes to K-12 students in need. A mini-wardrobe consists of 5 new pairs of underwear, 5 new pairs of socks, 5 short and 2 long sleeve tops, 2 pairs of pants and 3 pairs of shorts, 1 pair of sneakers, 1 hooded sweatshirt and additionally for middle school females 1-2 new sport bras. They sponsor clothing drives, various fundraising events and partner with Help4kids/ Backpack Buddies. (MBCC has sponsored Backpack Buddies in 2020 and 2021.)

Our money will go toward mini-wardrobe clothing outfits.

Members are volunteers that serve our community by making a variety of quilted items like Quilts of Valor for Veterans which several MBCC members have received. For 4 years they have donated a basket that included a Corvette Quilt and Corvette items for our car show. They also make Quiltlets for newborns at Conway Medical Center, Comfort Quilts and Pillow Cases for Waccamaw Oncology patients (Tidelands Health) and local Oncology units. Additionally they make Animal Beds for Horry County Animal Shelter, Breast Cancer Pillows, Walker Bags, Adult Bibs, Fidget Quilts for local Assisted Living Homes, Quilt Bags for children in distress and masks for Cancer Centers, Hospitals, etc. They were one of our charities in 2022. They will use the money for supplies.

Hope Harbor Home

Hope Harbor Home strives to break the cycle of domestic and sexual violence in Brunswick County, NC through safe shelter, advocacy and education. Founded in 1988 they are the only domestic violence program and shelter in Brunswick County. They rely on volunteers and 3 full time victim advocates who aid in everything from restraining orders to shelter in their 15 bed facility. They provide a 24-hour crisis hotline, employment and housing assistance, empowerment support group and victims advocacy. Additionally they operate thrift stores to aid their donations and fundraising efforts. The money we give them will go toward the construction of a new domestic violence shelter. As a construction sponsor, our club name will be listed on a commemorative marquee.

Canine Angels

Canine Angels, based in Horry County has been sponsored by the club a couple of times and is a current 2025 charity. They take dogs to senior living facilities, schools, hospice, libraries and more.


